



Volunteer Position Group Facilitator

Purpose

To provide a safe, caring environment for children, preteens, teens, young adults and adults grieving the loss of a significant relationship through death.

Responsibilities

- Agree to one-year commitment
- Honor statement of confidentiality
- Honor facilitator guidelines
- Cooperate with staff, monitor and fellow facilitators in implementing the format for a particular group
- Full participation in pre- and post-sessions (5:30 arrival and 9:00 departure)
- Assist in clean-up of room after group time
- Provide feedback on appropriate activities for next session
- Provide advance notice to the volunteer director when unable to attend

Qualifications

- Must be 16 years old or older and care about children
- Be able to sit on a cushion on the floor
- Work as a team member
- Agree to criminal background check prior to assuming duties
- Be able to work in a confidential environment

Supervision

Volunteer Director and Program Director

Time Commitment

The following are the time commitments for the various groups:

- Evening program peer-support groups: 5:30 – 9:00 p.m. every other week on a designated night (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)
- Attend 18-hour training class (broke up into 4-hours)
- Attend two-per year continuing education presentations (one hour).
