



Volunteer Position House Parent

Purpose

To provide a safe, caring environment for children, preteens, teens, young adults and adults grieving the loss of a significant relationship through death.

Responsibilities

- Honor houseparent guidelines
- Set up program area/kitchen area for evening meals
- Greet and welcome families upon arrival
- Assist with locating name tags
- Label pizza boxes, set-up drinks, paper plates, etc.
- Be available to assist families during the meal
- Assist in clean-up of room after dinner
- Report any areas of concern to staff person
- Clean Volcano room and Quiet room

Qualifications

- Must be 16 years old or older and care about children
- Can be 13 years old and older when accompanied by an adult
- Work as a team member
- Willing to interact with families and other volunteers
- Agree to a criminal background check prior to assuming duties
- Be able to work in a confidential environment
