## **Thirty Years of Erin's House**



In Memory of Erin Farragh: March 15, 1984 – January 5, 1989

Erin's House for Grieving Children is named for Erin Farragh. Erin was almost six when she died suddenly in her home in Fort Wayne on January 5, 1989. Her death left a deep void in the lives of her family and friends.

A friend of the Farragh family, Tracie Martin, was attending the National Junior League conference with other local members when they first heard about a special project at Fernside Center for Grieving Children in Cincinnati. Erin's

parents, David and Gail, were able to find support groups for themselves, but not for Erin's siblings, Tony and Megan, thus the idea for a similar grieving center for children was born. Shortly after returning home, our local Junior League learned GTE was offering grants for projects to help families within Northeast Indiana who were in crisis. After much discussion and collaboration, GTE generously contributed \$12,000 to kick off the project, along with Greenlawn Memorial Park who gave \$2,500. A portion of these funds were used to conduct a feasibility study to determine whether a center for grieving children was a necessary service within Fort Wayne and surrounding areas.

A community forum was announced within the greater Fort Wayne area to investigate the level of interest and need. Facilitated by Junior League members and staff from children's grieving centers in other states, it was attended by more than 200 people.

In November of 1992, the feasibility study concluded that the needs of grieving children were not being served and a grief center for the Fort Wayne community was vital. Just one year later, Erin's House for Grieving Children opened our doors.

## **Erin's House for Grieving Children Today**

The vision for Erin's House has remained the same throughout our 30 years as an organization. We are here to provide a compassionate environment that fosters hope and healing for all youth who are grieving throughout Northeast Indiana. Erin's House is funded solely through private donations from individuals, foundations, and corporations. Because of our generous supporters, families are never charged a fee for services.

The mission of Erin's House for Grieving Children is to provide support for children, teens, and their families who have experienced a death. Because grief can often cause children to feel isolated and different from their friends, peer support in itself helps youth in their grieving process. Knowing that they are not alone in their thoughts and feelings helps children cope in this strange new world of missing someone.

## **Principles**

- Erin's House is founded on the belief that every child and teen deserves the opportunity to grieve in a supportive and understanding environment.
- Grief is a natural reaction to death for children, as well as adults.
- · Within everyone is the natural capacity to heal oneself.
- The duration and intensity of grief are unique for each individual.
- · Caring and acceptance assist in the healing process.



What do you hope to bring to Erin House through your service as a board member? I have quite a bit of marketing and video production experience that I hope will be an asset to Erin's House.


## BRIAN TERNET

The joy I felt when she answered a resounding, "YES, of course!" NyAsia enjoys her group – they were her friends to invite!

I am so happy that this is a center where ALL are welcomed, and we do not have to worry if we have the right insurance coverage to afford us the opportunity to come to get help!

If I were to tell a friend about Erin's House, I would tell them Erin's House is really helpful and it is fun to get to socialize with others our age in group and do the fun activities.

A special memory I have of my Grandma Cuffy is how caring she was. For my Grandma Hunt, I will always remember going to her house every Sunday for a family meal and devotions. My Grandpa Hunt loved to ride in his golf cart. Somedays he would even let me drive him.

When I was surprised with the birthday party, I really didn't expect it. At first, I thought this was just what Erin's House did for people's birthdays, but then I found out my mother had planned it. I think my favorite highlight from the party was getting the tiara and sash to wear!
